Research Uses of the Internet

- Current Not Retrospective Information
 - Company homepages, news, financials
 - Government sites, federal & state
 - Finding people

Where to Start

- Define the subject matter
- Determine likely organization with answer
- General or Legal
- Use Directory (Findlaw, Yahoo, etc.)
- Go straight to a site that may have the information (guess the URL)
- Have URL Just type and go
- Search engines for unique words and phrases

Search Engines

v Altavista

- Powerful, large database, use +, default fuzzy OR, can truncate with *, use NEAR, OR, AND NOT

v Hotbot

- Options, all words, any words, exact phrase, person, URL use when the others fail
 - http://www.hotbot.com

v Excite

- Simple searches, use AND, OR +
 - http://www.excite.com
